

Declaration on the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU

As a global company, the Wölfer Motoren GmbH considers the sustainable protection of the environment and natural resources as its obligation. In this context, the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union passed Directive 2011/65/EU (Directive on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment) on June 8, 2011. In conjunction with the relevant corrections, delegated directives and Directive (EU) 2017/2102 the ban of the substance for lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls, polybrominated diphenylethers, di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate, butylbenzylphthalate, dibutylphthalate and diisobutylphthalate came into force.

Wölfer Motoren GmbH familiarized itself with the requirements of the RoHS directive at an early stage. To the best of our knowledge, none of the products currently manufactured by Wölfer Motoren GmbH are affected by the aforementioned directive. These electric motors are designed for stationary industrial systems (see Directive 2011/65/EU Article 2 Section (4) c) d)) and are installed there.

We will continue to observe the latest developments to reduce pollution in order to maintain and continuously improve the quality of our products.
